Sanctity of Human Life Sunday here at St. Paul next Sunday. It is a Sunday for us to focus on the value of each and every human life. It is a celebration of God's gift of life, and a memorial remembrance of the estimated 57 million children who have been lost the 1973 U.S. Supreme Court decisions Roe v. Wade, which legalized abortion in every state for any reason through all nine months of pregnancy. President Ronald Reagan issued a proclamation creating the first National Sanctity of Human Life Day in January 1984, and it included these words: "We have been given the precious gift of human life, made more precious still by our births in or pilgrimages to a land of freedom.
