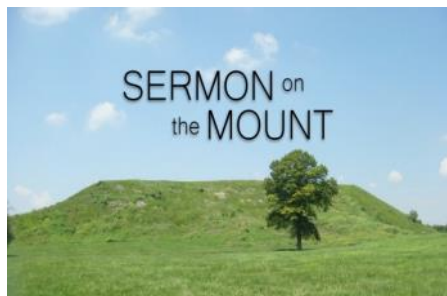
LET'S TALK — MALE & FEMALE
