## Preschool Fundraising!

We are phasing out the "purchasing the cards in the narthex" program and are moving into the ONLINE Scrip program. It's very simple: just go to [www.shopwithscrip.com](http://www.shopwithscrip.com) and register, you will need to input St. Paul Lutheran Church and Preschool's code: 439BDLL514285.

After you register you will have two options for purchasing SCRIP.

- 1) Submit your order online, drop your payment off at the church office. Due to shipping costs (\$8.75 per order) we will place one order per month on the 15th. The SCRIP will be delivered to you when it is received at church.
- 2) Set up a Presto Pay account that links to your checking account- then you can purchase SCRIP immediately—as printable gift cards—from your own home and at a cost of only \$0.15 per order.
